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## **Internal and external emergency response plans**

### *Definitions*

*Article 2(28) 'internal emergency response plan'.*

*Article 2(36) 'external emergency response plan'.*

*Article 2(32) 'oil spill response effectiveness'.*

*Article 2 (6) 'suitable'.*

### *Internal emergency response plans*

*Article 11.1(g), Article 14, Article 28 and Article 30 Annex1 Part 10.*

### *External emergency response plans*

*Article 29, Article 30, Annex 7 and 8.*

## **Article 11 and Article 14 Internal Emergency Response Plans**

### *Documents to be submitted*

*Article 11.1(g)*

*The internal emergency response plan or an adequate description there of, in accordance with Article 14 and 28.*

*Article 14 (1)*

*Duty on owners/operators to prepare internal emergency response plans in accordance with Article 28, the ROMH and also include an analysis of the oil spill response effectiveness.*

## **Article 14(2) and (3)**

*14 (2) for mobile non-production installations carrying out well operations, the internal emergency response plan is to take into account the risk assessment undertaken during notification of well operations A.11.1.(h)*

*14(3) in the event that a non production installation is to be used for carrying out combined operations, the internal emergency response plan shall be submitted to the competent authority to compliment the relevant notification of the combined operation.*

## **Article 29**

### **External emergency response plans**

*Member States shall prepare external emergency response plans covering all offshore oil and gas installations or connected infrastructure and potentially affected areas within their jurisdiction.*

*External emergency response plans shall be prepared by the Member State in cooperation with relevant operators, relevant licensees and competent authority.*
